AGREEMENT WITH PARTICIPANT OF THE PROJECT

hereinafter referred to as the "Agreement",
between

hereinafter referred to as the "University",

and

hereinafter referred to as the "Project Participant".

hereinafter collectively referred to as the "Parties".

The Parties have agreed on the following terms of the Agreement:

§1 – SUBJECT OF THE AGREEMENT

1. The subject of this Agreement is to establish the rules for granting and disbursing financial support for mobility to the Participant of the project "Green Wrocław University of Science and Technology in Unite!", implemented under the NAWA programme "European Universities Support – 2025". The programme is financed by the European Union under the European Funds for Social Development 2021–2027 (FERS), within the project "Support for European University Alliances", project no. FERS.01.05-IP.08-0219/23.
2. The University will provide the Project Participant with funding related to participation in a form of support requiring mobility, aimed at acquiring competencies or qualifications entitled:.....
3. The University shall provide the Project Participant with financial support in connection with participation in a mobility-based Form of support, aimed at acquiring competencies or qualifications entitled:.....
4. The Form of support starts on and ends on and lasts for days. The venue for the Form of support is
5. The mobility support includes:
 - a. a lump-sum for travel expenses;
 - b. a lump-sum for subsistence and accommodation costs;
 - c. a mobility scholarship.

6. The Project Participant undertakes to participate in the Form of support referred to in p. 3 above, in accordance with the rules set out in the Project Regulations, the Recruitment Regulations, and Regulations on the payment of mobility lump-sum allowances and scholarships.
7. The Project Participant confirms that they have familiarised themselves with the documents referred to in p. 6 above, and accept the provisions contained therein.

§2 – FINANCIAL SUPPORT

1. The total amount of mobility support awarded to the Project Participant is PLN (in words:). The total amount comprises:
 - a. a lump sum for travel expenses, which is PLN (in words:), results from mobility on the route -
 - b. a lump sum for subsistence and accommodation costs, which is PLN (in words: is based on the daily rate of and the number of mobility days:;
 - c. a mobility scholarship in the amount of PLN (in words:), is based on a daily rate of PLN and the number of mobility days:
2. Lump sums are not subject to personal income tax.
3. In the case of Project Participants who are employees or doctoral candidates of Wrocław University of Science and Technology, they shall be required to submit a declaration of expenses incurred in connection with the mobility and documents confirming such expenses. Where the actual expenses incurred are lower than the amount of the lump-sum allowances paid, the difference exceeding the value of the actual expenses incurred shall constitute the basis for the calculation of social security contributions and other charges required under applicable law.
4. The mobility scholarship shall be paid directly to the Project Participant. The University shall make any deductions required by generally applicable laws, in particular with regard to taxes or social security contributions, where the obligation to calculate and withhold such amounts arises under applicable legal provisions.

§3 – PAYMENTS TO THE PROJECT PARTICIPANT

1. Project Participant within 21 days following the completion of the Form of Support and the proper settlement of the mobility.
2. The payment of the funding referred to in §2 is conditional upon the Project Participant's participation in the Form of Support for which they have been qualified.
3. Participation in the Form of support shall be evidenced by documents appropriate to the given Form of support, including in particular attendance lists, certificates of participation, confirmations issued by the Host Entity, or other documents confirming participation in the mobility
4. Where the Project Participant fails to attend all days of the Form of Support for which they have been qualified, the lump-sum contribution towards subsistence and accommodation costs and the mobility scholarship shall be paid only where the absence is duly justified by unforeseen circumstances. The decision in this matter is made by the Project Manager.
5. In the case of non-participation in the form of support for which the Project Participant was
6. qualified, the funding mentioned in §2 will not be paid.



7. In the case of losing the status of Project Participant before the start of the Form of support or
8. during its implementation, the person loses the right to any lump sum payments.
9. In the case of study visits and internships, a condition for the implementation of the mobility is the conclusion of a tripartite agreement between the Project Participant, the University, and the Host Entity. The template of such agreement is attached to the Regulations on the payment of mobility lump-sum allowances and scholarships.
10. The payment will be made in Polish zlotys to the bank account of the Project Participant: within the deadline specified in p.1 above.

§4 – FINAL PROVISIONS

1. Any amendments to the Agreement must be made in writing, otherwise they are null and void.
2. The Parties shall not be liable for any failure to perform or improper performance of their obligations under this Agreement if such failure or improper performance results from force majeure.
3. The competent court for the resolution of any disputes arising from the performance of the
4. Agreement shall be the court of law, appropriate for the legal seat of the University
5. This Agreement has been drawn up in three identical copies, one for the Project Participant and two for the University.
